ABCP — The ABCP level is for individuals with less than two years of industry experience, but who have minimum knowledge in business continuity management, and have successfully passed the qualifying exam. This certification designation also targets interested individuals who have expertise in a related field (such as marketing, or emergency response) or in fields not directly related to business continuity planning.

CBCV — CBCV is for individuals with some knowledge in business continuity planning but who are not practitioners within an organization, rather they provide services to the industry and have acquired the necessary experience for certification. Any certified professional with active status may enhance their certification by completing the application requirements. You only pay an annual fee to maintain active CBCV status.

MBCP — Possess at least five years of significant practical experience in at least seven of the subject areas of the Professional Practices for Business Continuity Planners. Four of the seven subject areas must be the core subject areas: #3 Business Impact Analysis, #4 Developing Business Continuity Strategies, #6 Developing and Implementing Business Continuity Plans, and #8 Maintaining and Exercising Business Continuity Plans. Your experience must have occurred within 10 years of the date of your application and must reflect your business continuity/disaster recovery planning responsibilities and accomplishments—not other position responsibilities or organizational accomplishments.

CFCP/CBCP — Possess at least two years of significant practical experience in five of the subject areas of the Professional Practices for Business Continuity Planners. At least two of the five selected subject areas must be subject area #3: Business Impact Analysis, #4: Developing Business Continuity Strategies, #6: Developing and Implementing Business Continuity Plans, or #8: Maintaining and Exercising Business Continuity Plans. Your experience must have occurred within 10 years of your application date and focus on your business continuity/disaster recovery planning responsibilities and accomplishments—not other position responsibilities or organizational accomplishments. (CFCP certification requires a minimum of two years of experience in three subject matter areas, 1 of which must come from one of the four core areas, #3, #4, #6 or #8).
